GLOBAL WASHINGTON MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

1. **Featured as a member:** Your organization will be listed in Global Washington's online, printed, and media materials.
2. **Access to programs at member prices:** Attend educational seminars, trainings, and peer networking opportunities to increase partnerships and sharing of best practices at a reduced price or for free.
3. **Post positions on the Career Center website:** Global Washington has a job bank for volunteer, board, and paid positions and only members can access all three. There are also listings of consultants, job profiles from the international development sector, and information about local academic programs in the field.
4. **Submit blog postings:** You are invited to submit blogs postings regarding your organization, current issues in development, or Global Washington events for posting on Global Washington's website
5. **Promotion of events:** Global Washington will promote and often endorse your organization's events by posting on our events calendar, in our newsletter, and through our social networking sites.
6. **Participate in the NGO Initiative:** You will receive an invitation to join a Capacity Building Series we are including operational and programmatic topic areas members have requested. Scheduled to start in 2012
